### **Payments for Meets**

It is strongly recommend that you pre-pay for any meets. The **Booking form**, with payment details, is on page 3 of this Document.

We recognise that sometimes it is impossible to plan ahead, in which case we ask that you phone ahead to the steward's mobile phone: **07801 334321**, to check there is space available before you travel.

### **Arrival - Booking in**

The steward will approach you to welcome you and direct you to your allocated pitch, please remain in your vehicle, until you reach your pitch.

You **MUST** declare if you, or anyone within your party, has got Covid-19 and has **NOT** been in contact with another person who has, or has been suspected of having Covid-19 within the previous 14 days. (If the answer is Yes, you will **NOT** be permitted on site)

Without our wonderful stewards volunteering their time none of our meets would be possible. Please carefully follow instructions given by our Stewards during your arrival and booking in process, also any ongoing safety instructions given by them during your stay.

To comply with the Government Safety 'Track and Trace' Guidelines, on arrival you must provide contact details of the Lead Person in your Camping Unit.

### **Things to remember during your stay - Social distancing, particularly at the Water Point and Elsan Disposal Point, also Children and Pets**

You **MUST** maintain social distancing at all times from all those outside your camping unit and your allocated pitch. Please do not invite others into your Unit.

You are responsible for your own health and safety and must provide your own hand sanitisation and cleaning items. Wash your hands frequently and thoroughly.

As a family friendly camping group we love to see children running around, however these are unusual times and although we don't want to seem to be killjoys, we do ask parents to remind children in your care they must be in your control and remain within your allocated pitch, unless accompanied by an adult.

You are responsible for cleaning up your spillages at the Elsan Disposal Point and if possible, please use a face covering when emptying toilet cassettes.

Only enter the Controlled Zones at the Water Point and Elsan Disposal Point if no one else is in that zone. Please maintain social distancing at all times. Please take all your rubbish home with you.

Only Adults and Youth who have passed the Youth Test are permitted to collect water. Please kindly wash your hands before using the Water Point and after.

Only enter the Admin Tent / Stewards Unit if it's essential and always maintain a safe social distance during any communications.

As always, we ask that all pets are kept on leads at all times and that mess is cleaned up and safely disposed of. (Please remember to take all your rubbish home with you)

Please remember; 5mph maximum speed on site and no movement between the hours of 11pm and 7am.

Do not enter any farm buildings, this is for your health and safety.

### **Socialising – No social gathering or visitors**

This event is no longer a 'Social Gathering' and NO activities or social gatherings are permitted on site. Barbecues, etc., are OK but must be within your pitch with no participants from other units within the permitted social distancing guidelines, unless from your existing agreed Government 'Social Bubble.'

**Strictly no day visitors on site.**

### **Important**

If after you arrive, you or a member of your party, display symptoms of Covid-19, ie: High temperature, persistent cough, loss of sense of taste and/or smell, you ALL MUST RETURN HOME and seek medical guidance. Inform the Site Steward of your situation before departure, via the Mobile Phone Number provided above, or at the Steward's Unit, for Government Covid-19 Track and Trace purposes.

And above all enjoy your stay with Surrey DA and stay safe.
